PPC Renewables: the key to the green transition of the PPC Group

PPC Renewables is a 100% subsidiary of the PPC Group and has a groundbreaking activity, both at national and European level, in wind and solar energy since the 1980s.

With 40 wind parks, 20 small hydroelectric power plants, 46 photovoltaic stations and 1 hybrid system of a total installed capacity of approximately 1GW, PPC Renewables has a dynamic position in the Greek RES and creates the basis for leading the country's energy transformation.

Besides the above, the company constructs additional projects in Greece with a total capacity of more than 1.9GW.

At the same time, it grows its project portfolio both through organic growth, as well as through acquisitions and strategic partnerships. In this way, it significantly contributes to the overall goals of the PPC Group, which currently has in operation renewable energy projects in Greece and Romania with an installed capacity of 5.5GW (including large hydroelectric power plants), as well as projects under construction with a capacity of 3.8GW, with the aim of increasing its total installed project portfolio to 11.8GW by the end of 2027.
